Day 1Nov 29**

Honolulu → Narita → Hong Kong

We begin our vacation by boarding an international flight bound for **Hong Kong** via Narita. Hong Kong is one of the world's most cosmopolitan cities where East truly meets West. It is one of the world's most significant financial centers, shopping and food paradise cities.

Day 2* Nov 30

Hong Kong

Known as one of the world's most cosmopolitan cities, Hong Kong beautifully blends Eastern and Western cultures. It stands out as a major financial hub and a paradise for shopping and food enthusiasts. Upon arrival, an Air & Sea Travel representative will greet us and escort us to the hotel.

Day 3 **Dec 1**Hong Kong****(B)**

After breakfast at the hotel, we will embark on a **half-day tour** to explore the legendary highlights of Hong Kong, from breathtaking vistas to its charming corners. We will start at **Victoria Harbour**, where you can enjoy stunning views of the Symphony of Lights and Hong Kong Island's skyline across the water. Next, we will visit the **Avenue of Stars**, modeled after the Hollywood Walk of Fame. This waterfront avenue in Tsim Sha Tsui honors celebrities from the Hong Kong film industry. We will also stop at **Golden Bauhinia Square**, the emblem of Hong Kong. The Forever Blooming Bauhinia Sculpture, which gives the Expo Promenade its name, was a gift from the Central Government to commemorate the 1997 Handover—an event of great significance in 20th-century history. We will then go to **Victoria Peak**, a major tourist attraction that offers stunning views over Central Hong Kong, Victoria Harbor, Lamma Island, and the surrounding islands. In the afternoon, we will have the rest of the day to enjoy at our leisure.

Day 4 **Dec 2**Hong Kong – Zhuhai****(B, D)**

After enjoying breakfast in the hotel, please enjoy free time in the morning. Then we will transfer to Zhuhai by crossing **The Hong Kong–Zhuhai–Macau Bridge**. This bridge is a 55-kilometre bridge–tunnel system consisting of a series of three cable-stayed bridges, an undersea tunnel, and four artificial islands. It is both the longest sea crossing and the longest open-sea fixed link in the world. Upon arrival Zhuhai, we will watch **Chimelong International Circus Shows**, one of Asia's most renowned large-scale circus productions, celebrated for its world-class performers, breathtaking acrobatics, and spectacular stage effects. The show combines high-energy stunts, imaginative storytelling, dazzling costumes, and immersive lighting and sound to create an unforgettable entertainment experience for audiences of all ages. With international artists and grand theatrical design, it stands as a signature highlight of the Chimelong Resort and a must-see evening attraction in Zhuhai. After this fantastic show, we will enjoy dinner and then check in to our hotel in Zhuhai.

Day 5 **Dec 3**Zhuhai – Zhongshan****(B, L, D)**

After breakfast, we will enjoy our half day tour in Zhuhai. **Beishan Village** is a charming cultural enclave known for its preserved Lingnan-style architecture, quiet alleyways, and artistic atmosphere. The area features boutique cafés, galleries, and restored heritage buildings, offering guests a relaxed and authentic glimpse into Zhuhai's traditional community life. **Yeli Island**, connected to the city by a scenic causeway, Yeli Island is a peaceful coastal retreat with beautiful seaside views, landscaped walking paths, and open green spaces. **Zhuhai Fisher Girl**, the iconic Fisher Girl Statue, standing gracefully along Xianglu Bay, is one of Zhuhai's most beloved landmarks. Holding a pearl high above her head, she symbolizes beauty, love, and the city's connection to the sea. After lunch, we will transfer to our hot spring hotel. China's hot spring is one of the best-kept secrets. Hot springs are a geothermal heated natural springs with a water temperature of 5°C (10°F) or more above its surroundings. The hot springs are renowned for its therapeutic benefits all sorts of ailments from relieving rheumatism to stress relief to rejuvenating our body. **Zhongshan Hot Spring Resort**, a multi-functional resort, is comprised of a hotel, Luosanmei Mountain, golf course and a natural hot spring. The 0.5 square kilometer hotel sits on a 2.2 square kilometer. It consists of a number of gardens with many different functions and unique characteristics, which cater to both leisure and business travelers, featuring a natural setting with stunning mountain and lake views. The resort is China's first Sino-Foreign joint tourist venture enterprise. Feel relaxed and experience the natural hot springs in our hotel.

Day 6Dec 4****Zhongshan****(B, L, D)**

After enjoying breakfast at the hotel, we will have free time in the hotel in the morning. Later, we will transfer to Zhongshan. **Zhongshan**, known as Honolulu's Sister City, is the birthplace of Dr. Sun Yat-sen (also known as Dr. Sun Zhongshan). He was the first president and founding father of the Republic of China. On the way, we will visit **Caobian Village**, located in the South District of Zhongshan, is an ancient overseas-Chinese village founded in 1068 with a history of more than 800 years. The village preserves a rich collection of historical architecture from the Qing Dynasty and the Republic of China era, including watchtowers, stone-paved streets, ancestral halls, and traditional residences. Upon arrival in Zhongshan, we will check into our hotel. Tonight, we will gather for our dinner.

Day 7Dec 5****Zhongshan****(B, D)**

After enjoying the hotel breakfast, we will visit the **Zhongshan City Museum**, is a National Second-Class Museum that presents the rich history, culture, and development of Zhongshan. The museum holds a collection of more than 16,000 artifacts, including hundreds of precious cultural relics, and regularly hosts exhibitions covering local history, overseas-Chinese heritage, and cultural development. Then, we will transfer to **Zhongshan Sunxi Walking Street** (Sunwen Road West or Sunwen Xilu) in Zhongshan Old Town, a pedestrian mall lined with dozens of restored buildings from the colonial period in treaty port style. Several of these buildings were built in the 1920s. We can enjoy our own lunch here. Then, we will attend **the Chrysanthemum Exhibition** in Xiaolan Town where local folks have kept their practice of flower cultivation for several hundred years. There are over 3,000 different varieties and colors of chrysanthemum flowers. The chrysanthemum is a traditional subject in Chinese artwork and literature and is one of the "Four Gentlemen" of China (the others are the plum blossom, the orchid, and bamboo). The bloom and specified horticulture of chrysanthemum has given the town the famous name, "the City of Chrysanthemum". Tonight, a special **Chrysanthemum Banquet** has been arranged for lunch. We will return to Zhongshan, where you can enjoy the rest of the day at your leisure.

Day 8Dec 6****Zhongshan – Shenzhen****(B, L)**

After breakfast, we will transfer to **Shenzhen**, in southeastern China, is a modern metropolis that links Hong Kong to China's mainland. Upon arrival, we will go to **Qianhai OCT Harbor**, is a national 5A-level scenic area and one of the city's most vibrant coastal leisure destinations. Blending waterfront scenery, cultural entertainment, dining, shopping, and artistic spaces, the complex offers a modern urban-resort atmosphere ideal for both daytime exploration and evening entertainment. After lunch, we will transfer to our hotel and check-in. Tonight, we can enjoy shopping in **Luohu Shopping Complex** (Luo Hu Commercial City), one of Shenzhen's most well-known shopping locations. It located at the Luohu Border, directly across from the Shenzhen Railway Station, and features a five-story shopping center selling a wide range of items. We will enjoy the rest day on our own.

Day 9Dec 7****Shenzhen – Hong Kong → Haneda → Honolulu****(B)**

Today, we will transfer to Hong Kong International Airport for our return flight home via Haneda, taking with us lasting memories of this wonderful tour to China.
