Day 1Dec 2**

Honolulu → Narita → Hong Kong

We begin our vacation by boarding an international flight bound for **Hong Kong** via Narita. Hong Kong is one of the world’s most cosmopolitan cities where East truly meets West. It is one of the world’s most significant financial centers, shopping and food paradise cities.

Day 2Dec 3**

Hong Kong

Upon arrival, an Air & Sea Travel representative will greet us and escort us to the airport hotel.

Day 3 **Dec 4

Hong Kong – Zhuhai

(B, D)

After enjoying breakfast in the hotel, we will transfer to Zhuhai by crossing **The Hong Kong–Zhuhai–Macau Bridge**. This bridge is a 55-kilometre bridge–tunnel system consisting of a series of three cable-stayed bridges, an undersea tunnel, and four artificial islands. It is both the longest sea crossing and the longest open-sea fixed link in the world. Upon arrival Zhuhai, we will enjoy a half day city tour. **Zhuhai Fisher Girl**, the iconic Fisher

Girl Statue, standing gracefully along Xianglu Bay, is one of Zhuhai's most beloved landmarks. Holding a pearl high above her head, she symbolizes beauty, love, and the city's connection to the sea. We will have a photo stop of the **Zhuhai Grand Theater**, also known as the Sun & Moon Shells, is one of Zhuhai's most iconic modern landmarks. Located on **Yeli Island** along the scenic Lovers' Road coastline, it is China's only opera house built on an island, instantly recognizable by its two striking shell-shaped structures—one large, one small—symbolizing the rising sun and the glowing moon. After dinner, we will check-in to our hotel.

Day 4 **Dec 5 **Zhuhai → Fuzhou** **(B)**

After breakfast, we will visit **Beishan Village** is a charming cultural enclave known for its preserved Lingnan-style architecture, quiet alleyways, and artistic atmosphere. The area features boutique cafés, galleries, and restored heritage buildings, offering guests a relaxed and authentic glimpse into Zhuhai's traditional community life. We will enjoy our own lunch here. After that, we will transfer to Zhuhai airport for a flight to **Fuzhou**. Fuzhou, a city in south China across the strait from Taiwan, is famous for its sea views, mountains and historical sites. As the capital and one of the largest cities in Fujian Province, Fuzhou is also known as the “city of banyans”, because of the numerous banyan trees planted there. We will check-in to the hotel after arrival.

Day 5Dec 6** **Fuzhou** **(B, L, D)**

Fuzhou may not be as popular as the top Chinese tourist cities like Beijing, Shanghai and Hangzhou, but it is an ideal tourist destination with mild weather and graceful natural scenery. It features spectacular forest parks, unique gardens, historic temples, ancient-style architecture and old streets. Located in the downtown area of Fuzhou, the **Three Lanes and Seven Alleys (Sanfang-Qixiang)** is a district of streets featuring a cluster of ancient residential buildings and is the largest well-preserved historical heritage site in China, referred to as the ‘Architecture Museum’. After lunch, we will continue our tour to **Xi Chan Ancient Temple**, also known as Xichan Temple, is one of Fuzhou's Five Great Buddhist Temples and a nationally recognized key Buddhist site. With a history dating back over 1,150 years, it stands as one of the most important Chan (Zen) temples in southern China. After dinner we will return to our hotel.

Day 6Dec 7** **Fuzhou  Wuyishan** **(B, D)**

Today, we will take the **High Speed Train** to Wuyishan, in the north-western part of Fujian Province and is the most scenic mountain in Southeast China. Cut off from the outer mountains, **Wuyishan** is surrounded by streams and valleys. Upon arrival, we will immerse ourselves in **Wuyi Mountain's tea culture** through a guided **tea-picking** and **tea-making experience**, discovering the craftsmanship behind the world-renowned Dahongpao. After dinner, we will check-in to our hotel. Tonight, an Outdoor Musical Show “**Impression Dahongpao**” will be arranged. Impression Dahongpao is an unprecedented "matrix type" movie, integrating 15 movie screens into the natural landscape, forming the "matrix type" wide real movie scenes to create the effect of a dream-like scene. The outdoor theater is the World's biggest and the first to introduce a 360 degree rotating auditorium, presenting the one and only “Rotating View Theatre”.

Day 7Dec 8** **Wuyishan** **(B, L)**

Today's highlight is the **World Natural Heritage – Wuyishan National Park**. We will explore **Tianyou Peak**, which is surrounded by the Nine-bend Stream on three sides. From the top of Tianyou Peak you will have a panoramic view of Mt. Wuyishan and the sea of clouds after rain or at dawn. **Wuyi Palace** now preserves two Dragon wells, Wannian Palace and Sanqing Hall. Wannian Palace serves as the memorial hall of Zhu Xi Memorial Hall. The Song Dynasty Street is 300-meters long and starts from the Memorial Hall of Zhu Xi. The most exciting part of today will be the **Jiuquxi River Rafting**. Jiuquxi River is praised as the "Soul of Mt. Wuyishan Scenic Area" and is famous for natural sceneries of mountain and water along the river. To appreciate the beautiful scenery of Jiuquxi River, the best choice is to take a **bamboo raft**, made of eight or nine bamboo rods. This river crossing tool has a history of thousand years and features a shallow body with lighter buoyancy. After that, we will return to our hotel and enjoy the rest of day on our own.

Day 8Dec 9****Wuyishan  Xiamen****(B, L)**

Today, we will take the **High Speed Train** to **Xiamen**, also known as Amoy, a beautiful, coastal city in southeastern China. Upon arrival, we will enjoy our lunch and check-in to our hotel. We can enjoy the rest of day on our own.

Day 9Dec 10****Day trip to Gulanyu Islet****(B, L, D)**

Today, we will explore **Gulangyu Islet** by ferry. Villas and mansions on the islet are ornate and add much charm to the satellite island. We will make a stop at **Guanfu Museum & Piano Museum** to take a look at their antique collections. **Shuzhuang Garden** is an embodiment of three important principles of garden design - hiding elements, profiting from the natural surroundings and combining movements. After lunch, we will visit **Hi Heaven Villa** (or Sea & Sky Villa) built by Philippine Chinese Huang Xiuhuoliang. After enjoying the **Traditional Puppet show** and **Ancient Nanyin Music Concert**, we will return to Xiamen.

Day 10Dec 11****Xiamen → Shanghai****(B, D)**

After breakfast, we will transfer to the airport for our flight to Shanghai. **Shanghai** is the most populous city in China. Due to its rapid growth in the last two decades, it has again become a global city, exerting influence over finance, commerce, fashion, and culture. Upon arrival, an Air and Sea Travel representative will greet us and take us to our hotel for check-in. Dinner will be arranged tonight.

Day 11Dec 12****Shanghai****(B)**

Today, we can enjoy our free day and explore the city of Shanghai. Suzhou optional tour will be available.

Day 12Dec 13****Shanghai → Kansai → Honolulu****(B)**

Today, we will transfer to Shanghai International Airport for our return flight home via Kansai, taking with us lasting memories of this wonderful tour to China.
